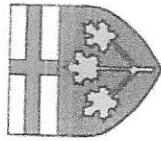
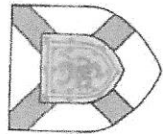


Allen (Al) Rusnak - Master Instructor - Canadian Firearms Safety Course

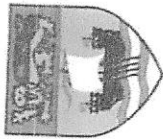
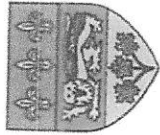
I received my Master Instructor, Canadian Firearms Safety Course (CFSC) certification in 1994 by participating in a four day program offered by the Federal Government in cooperation with the provincial government. The participants had various backgrounds including police, fish & wildlife, hunter education and educators. I participated in the course and was selected one of only 50 people that received certification. The program included Train the Trainer training which I found very valuable. The master instructor rating allowed me to train and certify other instructors. When the Alberta Hunter Education Instructors Association took on the task of running the CFSC program from the Federal government the rules were changed and they became responsible for certifying instructors and controlling the number of instructors in the province.

In my youth I was raised on a farm and had the opportunity to use firearms at an early age. I joined the Royal Canadian Sea Cadets and received formal training in the use of firearms on a formal rifle range where safety was paramount. In my adult life I joined the Cadet Reserves and became a Sea Cadet officer and ran shooting program with the cadet corps. In order to run the program I had to qualify as a range officer. Next I participated in a hunter education course as was really motivated by the content and that it really enhanced my outdoor experiences. My next step was to become an instructor in the program. The program offered many instructor workshops that enhanced my instructor capability and qualifications. I achieved an "A" instructor rating which allowed me to train and certify instructors. It was at this time that I recommended to participate in the CFSC instructor program.

In adult life I have worked for ATCO Electric and in my career I have had the opportunity to organize and develop training programs as well as deliver training. I really enjoy sharing my knowledge with people who are like minded and want them to learn and have success from my instruction. To me the CFSC is about firearms safety and the responsibility that comes with owning firearms 24 hours a day seven days a week.



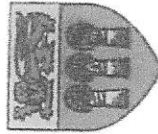
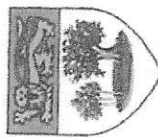
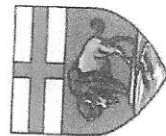
